CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The mysteries of synthesis and trafficking

As every EMG Conference, the Conference in Lyon 2019 will be complemented by “Free Communications” which are aiming to involve young professionals working in the field of inborn errors of metabolism.

As the number of places at the EMG Conference is limited, an accepted abstract for the “Free Communication” session is equal to an additional invitation.

We would like to give younger colleagues working in your hospital as well as working in a cooperating centre the chance to participate in the EMG Conference 2019 and therefore open the “Call for Abstracts” in the very first instance to them. The submission offers them the chance to present their research in front of a very experienced audience and to establish contacts on an international level. Time for presentation will be 10 minutes + 5 minutes time for discussion.

In addition we will honor the two best presentations (structure of presentation, presentation skills, timing, etc.) by giving the winners a wild card (personal invitation) to the EMG Conference in 2020.

PRINCIPLES FOR ABSTRACTS

The abstracts can be related either to the main topic of the conference: “The mysteries of synthesis and trafficking” **or** to inborn errors of metabolism in general.

Abstracts should focus either on:

1. clinical relevant topics, e.g. outstanding case reports or on
2. recent lab related findings

The abstract should not exceed one DIN A4 page (12pt Arial font, 1.5-spaced) and is requested to contain the following information:

- Area the abstract belongs to (please tick on abstract template):
 1. clinically relevant
 2. latest lab results
- Title
- Author
- Institute: University, department, city, country

We kindly ask the applicants to give us the following personal information:

- age of applicant allocated to 5-years brackets (e.g. 21–25, 26–30, 31–35...)
- years of experience in metabolic diseases
- current focus on lab or clinical work
- note if abstract refers to a new discovered disease

SELECTION OF ABSTRACTS

All submitted abstracts will be collected and distributed to the Advisory Board of the EMG. The board will select 6 abstracts with clinical focus and 6 abstracts lab related for presentation.

Authors will be informed about acceptance of abstracts at the beginning of April 2019. Accepted abstracts will be published in the “Book of Abstracts”, which will be distributed during the EMG Conference.
